## Poster Child Nominee Criteria

- Submit a 2-3 minute video or write an essay on “Why I Should be the Face of the MS Sickle Cell Foundation?” (essay-no more than a page)
- Must be under the age of 15 years old.
- Must reside in the State of Mississippi.
- Must have sickle cell disease. A letter from the child’s physician verifying their sickle cell status may accompany the application.
- Must be active in the sickle cell community by either attended Camp Sickle Stars, sponsored an awareness event in your community (walk/blood drive/etc.), or has written an essay for a school project on sickle cell disease.
- Must be enrolled in school and maintained a C average or better. Must show progress report or report card.
- Ability to help with awareness and fundraising events sponsored by the MS Sickle Cell Foundation.
- Ability to speak in front of a class, audience, and/or media, to promote and/or raise awareness about sickle cell disease.
- Must submit 1 (one) letter of recommendation from doctor, teacher, church and/or support group.
- Parent(s) and/or caregiver of the winning child **must** assure that his/her child will attend multiple activities sponsored for/by the **MS Sickle Cell Foundation.**
- Must include 2 or more photos. Note: all photos and material will become the property of the **MS Sickle Cell Foundation.**
